- ▶ T20 Grade cricket match.
- As the umpires are leaving the field at the completion of the 1st innings, they are informed that the scorebook totals are 20 runs apart.
- ▶ The scorers don't know what to do.
- 1) Describe in detail how you would manage this situation.
- 2) What method is used to reach agreement on the total?



BALANCING THE SCOREBOOK

- Cross reference everything in both books.
- ▶ Runs scored by all batsmen + byes + leg byes + wides + no balls = total
- Runs against all bowlers + byes + leg byes = total
- Ensure the overs against the individual bowlers equals the total bowled.
- ► Check that all wides & no-balls against each bowler equals the total number recorded in the sundries column.
- Ask the scorers at what over did the books last add up correctly?
